WAHM [work at home moms] is quite a popular niche; last month alone 18,100 searches were run on <u>Google</u> – that reflects a red-hot niche, where moms are interested to expand their income and looking into various opportunities and jobs.

Work at Home Mom Revolution talks about how to manage working at home with children; its focus is on work-At-Home Opportunities and Mom News.

No matter what the ages of your children, it is crucial to schedule your time and blog publishing frequency properly if you work at home. With more and more moms working at home full and part time, this is a great topic to write about on your blog. But it's not only about moms because dads can work at home, too (<u>like Noel does</u>).

Here's another example - **Rob Page** - a web designer who blogs @ <u>Big Robby</u> about iPhone, Halo, parenting and other cool stuff.

- Home Decorating -



- Going Green - Saving the Planet [eco-friendly products] -

More individuals and businesses are looking for ways to be more ecologically friendly. This isn't just a trend today but an actual way of the future.

You could share ways that you're going green in your life or business. You could also write about what people in your industry or niche are doing to go green. The ideas are endless.

<u>Green loop blog</u> shares nothing but eco fashion news and reviews; you'd find an entire category on <u>eco shoes</u> and a section on the latest <u>green events</u>.

If you want more "eco-friendly" ideas to blog about, here are some popular keywords

- Parenting Tips and Advice -

Parenting advice is some of the oldest and most well known information found on the Internet.

14,800 searches a month for "parenting tips" shows this might be a good niche to tap into and even develop a brand new blog around it.

If you have kids, your mind is probably already reeling with ideas you can write about. What is your funniest parenting moment? What's the scariest thing that ever happened to you as a parent? Use these ideas and filter them into a blog post.

You can add your own tips, ideas and philosophies about parenting. You don't have to run an exclusive parenting blog to blog about parenting. If you have kids, it's a fair game topic no matter what the subject matter of your blog.

<u>Dave Taylor</u>, a dad with three kids, blogs about attachment parenting and keeps his readers up-to-date on parenting news, and much more, @ <u>Aaparenting</u>



What you might not know about Dave is that he's also a movie enthusiast – on his other blog @ DaveOnFilm.com he actually writes about film theory and criticism, talks about the industry, and interviews people involved in film creation, production and distribution, including actors, directors, producers, and just about anyone else involved in turning an idea into a script and then a great movie.



- Making Money Blogging -

There are many ways you can make money while blogging, but there's not enough time to focus on them all. If you want to blog about blogging, it's smart you focus on niche subjects such as a specific monetization idea [e.g. AdSense]

A true classic example is <u>Steve Pavlina</u>'s post <u>How to Make Money From Your Blog</u> [his blog actually reached \$1k a day in income back in 2006; that's \$30,000 a month]

Here are some of the sub-topics covered inside Steve's post:

- Do you actually want to monetize your blog?
- How Selfish Are You?
- Can you make a decent income online?
- Traffic, traffic, traffic
- Will putting ads on your site hurt your traffic?
- Multiple streams of income
- Comments or no comments
- Testing and optimization
- Posting frequency and length
- Motivation
- Blogging lifestyle

If you want to learn more about blogging, then let me introduce you to my buddy, <u>Darren Rowse</u>, the pro blogger himself. One of his best posts - <u>How Bloggers Make Money from Blogs</u> – received a whopping 802 comments as we speak.



- Social Networking -

Social networking is a hot thing today so when it comes to things to blog about, this is at the top of the charts. There are so many different areas in which you can discuss social networking. One of these is how to use it. You can give hints, tips and other related advice to people who visit your blog. Here are two great examples of other bloggers doing this very same thing:


- A Beginner's Guide to Social News Websites

For e.g. <u>151 Travel Tips for Seniors</u> gives travel advice for mature travelers, featuring tips on safety, health, packing, and more.

- Making Money Online -

This is a super hot topic and it's not likely that will change any time soon. With an economy that can fluctuate from year to year, many people love the idea of making extra money online. However, not everyone knows how to go about it.

This is why they go to the Internet for help and with your guidance they may find the path to their financial freedom.

Here are some Google keyword ideas to get the big picture and understand why this niche is one of the most profitable, although it's pretty small compared with "health" or "financial" related niches

- Technology News -

Technology is always changing and it will continue to change. This is what makes writing about technology news an awesome topic, particularly if you're passionate about the latest gadgets, computers and Internet.

People want to hear about the latest cool stuff they could be using in their life, to improve their computer experience and the business of their own.

If you provide them with the right info on your blog, you can bet they will come back again and again for more [that's how you guarantee sticky readers]

You can look up technology in your niche as well as other topics. It's highly beneficial to blog about these topics that other people are going to be looking for and it can also be a learning experience for you as a way to keep up with what's new and what's happening.

Here are some specific ideas to blog about:

For those who dare to phone different – <u>the iPhoneBlog</u> shares iPhone news, reviews and opinions.

For Mac enthusiasts you have news and rumors @ MacRumors dot com



For Windows fans, you have Windows 7 blog packed with the latest news & tips



Your blog has computer and technology fans; your aim is to uncover their wants and provide them with the latest updates to keep them happy and come back often.

- Holidays -

Is there an upcoming holiday or special occasion? These are always hot topics on blogs and they come around every year so there is always something to write about. There are so many different angles you can take on a blog post about the holidays that you have nothing to lose. No matter what type of blog you have, you can write about the holidays.

Halloween might be an over used topic, so you could look for other red-hot subjects.

Here are some examples:

- For Mother's Day check this blog
- For <u>Thanksgiving Day</u> check this blog <u>here</u>

Other Holidays you could consider:

- Labor Day
- New Year's Day
- Valentine's Day
- Easter Sunday

Think about the many ways that you can do this for yourself. You might create how-to postings and videos for arts and crafts for the holiday or making you will make a top 10 list of things to do on that holiday or gifts to buy. You can even do Top 10 reasons to not like the holiday or something controversial that will encourage debate and comments.

Use this <u>calendar selection site</u> to look out for upcoming Holidays and plan your posts accordingly. It's a great helper and time saver.



- Relationship Tips and Advice -

Relationship tips and advice have been a popular blog topic for as long as blogs have been around and it's not likely this will change any time in the future. When you want something great to blog about, this is a good direction to look in.

If your blog audience is made of singles, why not come up with topics targeting their most burning needs and secret desires [meeting their soul mate, etc].

For example, Nerds do it better has a post on "Perfectly Fit: 50 Ways to Meet Healthy and Active Singles" - read it here

<u>David Sanford</u> and his wife propose a new positive approach to commitment on <u>Every</u> Day Love blog



What about a special Q&A section [or category] on your blog where your readers could ask you "relationships" related questions? Get inspiration from AskApril



A mature audience type of blog will definitely like a "relationship" related post at least once a month; if you don't like writing full blown posts on the topic, then you could have an illustration or something related to "marriage" to emphasize your ideas.

For e.g. check out <u>Marriage: Money Rules for Couples</u> – and write about similar ideas if your blog relates to financial topics.

- Observations on Culture and Technology -

When you want a great blog topic for use on your blog, why not make some observations on culture and technology? You can share your own opinions or link to the posts and articles of others that you agree with. Even better, you might link to posts of others that you don't agree with and then make points to debate with your blog post.

Here are some examples of this topic in action:

How does access (or lack of access) to digital technology effect a culture?

The Intersection of Culture and Technology

Now taking a look at what they've done, can you think of some ways you can write about culture, technology or both? You may also find some ways to tie this in to your niche and make it work on a regular basis. You'll draw in a new crowd interested in your blog.

- What Are You Reading? -

Have you read anything good lately? How about that great ebook on Web 2.0 you picked up for free yesterday? Did you learn any great new tips you can use yourself? Why not pass it on to others or at least do a great review of the book on your blog?

The great thing about this topic is that your blog doesn't have to be about books or writing for you to share opinions about a book you've read recently.

You should take time to write your own blog post when you've read a new book or ebook and share with others what you thought about it. This is also a great way to help promote authors if you know any and if you want to help share their books with others.

Sue writes AMAZON book reviews on her blog since 1999. She's a great inspiration!



Depending on your niche topic, you could start reviewing books on your specific industry and keep your readers interested in more cool stuff to read.

Here's another great example - Novel Teen Book Reviews – all about books...



"We love to read, and we want to help teens, parents, libraries, and schools find clean teen fiction to read and talk about."

- Politics Bring in the Hits -

People like to discuss the politics. Even more, they love to debate over the politics. This is why political articles can be so great for a blog. It brings in more readers and will spark debate and conversation. People are much more likely to leave comments on your blog, link to your post and refer it to friends when you write on something they feel passionate about.



- Product Reviews -

Ever since blogging came around people have been creating product reviews of one type or another. You can read product reviews on blogs about everything imaginable.

Every day people can post reviews of products they have tried for themselves and businesses can post reviews of their own products or products of others. This is what makes it a great blog topic because there's always something to write about. We use products and services on a daily basis. Think about those products you use and how you can make a blog posting about it.

Here are some examples:

This post talks about <u>finding product reviews before online shopping</u>. This is another great angle you can take on the blogging about product reviews topic. Tell people what to look for in a good review in one post or tell them in another blog post how they can find great reviews.

When you write your review, it's smart you **affiliate yourself** with the company or the product you promote; you're getting a commission each time the vendor close the sale on your behalf.

That's a great way to make money with your blog posts, without having to actually own a product or create it yourself.

- Apple Sucks and other Opinion Pieces -

Do you really want to get the <u>Apple Fanboys</u> in an uproar and bring traffic to your blog? Share your opinions on why you dislike Apple - or Republicans or green peas... Opinion pieces never get old and they are great traffic generators. If you're human being, you have opinions and what better place to share them than on your own blog!

There is even a <u>culture of opinion</u> and those who think you should <u>keep your opinion to yourself</u>. These are great examples of how you can write opinion pieces for your blogs. Write about what you like, what you don't like and everything in between.

It's your opinion so there is no one to tell you that you're wrong. You can write from the heart and it's a great way to spark comments and dialogue with your readers. You may even find that debate breaks out but that's ok; it means more blog hits.

- Fun Family Vacation Spots -

There are always families out there looking for good places to go on vacation or for some quick family fun. This is why this can be an excellent blog post idea. If you're in the travel niche or the family or parenting niche, it will be even better.

Who doesn't love to go on vacation or at least dream about the great vacation they want to take when they have the time or money? Use this to your advantage for a great blog post today.

- Best Magazine Articles -

Have you read an amazing magazine article and you want to be able to share it with your readers? Did you read a piece by an expert in your niche or maybe you browsed something interesting in the doctor's office?

Every time you read a magazine article, it's potential for a great blog post. This is also a great chance to bring in readers and share dialogue with your blog visitors. These are reasons why using magazine articles as blog post food-for-thought is a great idea.

Sometimes you just have to laugh at society and the things that people do. Well, why not share the laughter with some good, fun blog posts about the incidents? It's even more fun when the people are celebrities.

And if you use them often in your blogs, it can even be confusing to the readers. This is where a glossary post can come in handy. Buzzwords are always out there although the specific ones used can vary from time to time and even place to place or within different industries.

In the UK, <u>authorizes have warned bureaucrats to stop using buzzwords</u> as they confuse people and can be misleading. They even formed a body to create 100 top buzzwords to be avoided. On the flip side, the <u>Internet marketing scene says buzzwords sell</u> and that you should definitely use them in your material.

That last one brings up another good point - **blogging about or around quotations**. These are always a great way to get started when you're not sure what to blog about.

You don't have to run a comedy blog to make a humorous post now and then. It can even be a great way to lighten the mood on a usually serious blog. So you can see that this is a great blog post topic idea.

- Online Dating -

Online dating is ideal not only for singles who're looking to find their soul mate but also for men and women who are looking for romance and dating ideas.

Online dating is a big niche – <u>500,000 searches a month</u> on Google

You could be sharing tips, tricks and resources for online dating targeting your niche audience specifically

For example:

- Dating for baby boomers
- Online dating tips for men
- Online dating tips for women

Write an online dating post dedicated to the majority of your blog readership and monitor the feedback.

For example you could share dating tips for baby boomers if your blog audience is made mainly of baby boomers or single women if your audience is mainly single women.

You get the idea. The key here is to track your success rate [number of comments, back links and re-tweets, etc.]

If you got positive feedback, then prepare for an online dating series.

Blog Post Bonus Idea

- Top Tens Lists -

What is your top ten most embarrassing moments? What are the top ten worst foods you've ever heard of that people actually eat? There are so many great ideas for top tens that this list can't begin to cover all of. You can find top ten lists in every niche and whatever topic your blog is about. It's that easy and it's that fun!

For example:

A Top 10 List for Blogs (find the best blogs in your category)

Top 10 Top Tens (A top 10 list of the blogger's fave top 10s)

Fun top ten lists are a great way to get listed on <u>Digg</u>, <u>Reddit</u> and other sites. They also get you re-tweeted a lot on Twitter and can help you climb to the top of the listings for keywords on your blog search engines and regular search engines. People love this stuff- and why not? It's a great deal of fun!

And you don't have to limit yourself to a top 10 list. You could take this idea further and expand your list. Here are some cool examples [I bet you haven't heard about these yet]
